

Pesticide Warnings Required For The Following Products And Chemicals

A federal judge ordered that in West Coast cities of 50,000 or more, retailers who sell seven particular pesticides must post a sign — "Salmon Hazard" in large letters — along with a warning about hazards to salmon streams.

“SALMON HAZARD

**This product contains pesticides that may harm salmon or steelhead.
Use of this product in urban areas can pollute salmon streams.”**
